Ridgway RiverFest offers an afternoon of family-friendly fun and education celebrating the Uncompahgre River Watershed. This free annual festival features all-age river races including the Junk of the Unc homemade watercraft competition, awards and prizes, fun educational activities about local nature and outdoor recreation, live music, food, and beverages.

The RiverFest is produced by the Uncompahgre Watershed Partnership (UWP), a Ouray County-based nonprofit devoted to preserving and improving the natural, scenic and economic values of the Upper Uncompahgre Watershed, from the headwaters to the northern Ouray County line. Tax Deductions & Credits

UWP is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit (EIN: 46-2946756) so sponsorship donations are eligible for charitable tax deductions. Financial contributions at or above \$250 may be eligible for a 25% Colorado income tax credit (or 12.5% for in-kind contributions) for Colorado donors.

In-Kind Sponsorship Options

Silent Auction Donations

For sponsors who prefer to support RiverFest through donating products and certificates, your generous donation will raise money for UWP through a silent auction. Festivalgoers love getting great deals on restaurant, lodging, and trip certificates as well as outdoor gear, toys, art, and other goodies from local and national brands. People bid on donated silent auction items until 5 and 6 p.m., when bids are closed in two waves and top bidders purchase their items. Starting bids are typically 50% of the item's retail value, and most common winning bids are 60% to 70%.



Note: Silent auction donors will receive pro-rated Class I-V Sponsor Appreciation to match the typical financial value earned from auction buyers. Products, services and other silent auction valued at: \$4,500 and above = Class V; \$3,000-\$4,499 = Class IV; \$1,200-\$2,999 = Class III; \$700-\$1,199 = Class II; \$350-\$699 = Class I; and \$25-\$349 = Friends of the River. RiverFest staff is happy to help you understand which sponsor level your donated items will match.

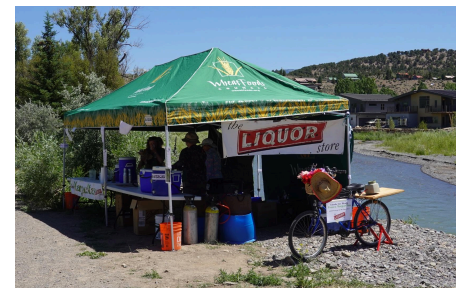
Junk of the Unc Prizes

Junk of the Unc entrants have the chance to win one of four prizes: Fastest Junk, Best Use of Reused/Recycled Materials, Most Artistic/Creative, and Best of Youth (20 years old & under).
